John 14:6 - "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

Craft Center Activity

Place pieces of blue tissue paper in bowl for "water". Color feet (if desired) and attach to side of bowl - sticking up so that the words can be seen. Talk about how Jesus washed the feet of his disciples to show them (and us) how we should serve others.

Supplies needed:

Cutout of feet
bowl
blue tissue paper
crayons
tape or glue

Let the child eat the bread and then the juice. Talk about how we partake in communion each week to remember what Jesus has done for us.

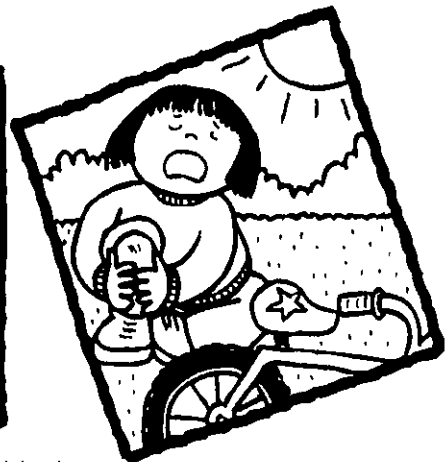
Worksheet Center Activity
